Last week we saw the end of the Liturgical year with the Feast of Christ the King. Now we enter the first week of Advent; this special time of reflection and preparation as we await to celebrate Christmas.

The children had a great time collecting and creating the greenery to make their class Advent Wreaths and worked together across year groups to make items for the School and Parish Christmas Bazaar which is being held this Saturday. Thank you to the parent helpers who came and assisted the children in this, especially Mrs Figueiredo who prepared so much in readiness for the day.

I am sure that the bazaar will be a wonderful event, so please don't forget to put it into your diaries and bring your family and friends along to support the hard working team that is putting it together. Thank you to everyone who has supported it by sending in items for sale and for the raffle and will support on the day by running stalls. I believe that we a have a special visitor who will be joining us again this year! The school honey will also be on sale.

On Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> November, I attended Clifton Cathedral on behalf of our school community with Mrs Simone Thurbon, Vice Chair of Governors, for the launch by Bishop Declan of the year of 'Mission' as part of his call to become People of Hope. It was a very special service, when we collected information to support our school as part of this journey. As a result, we will be asking our children, parents, staff and community to reflect on our school Mission statement and how we aim to put this into action within school and working with the wider community.
